

Grades 4-8 Minimum URS Matrix

The Minimum Universal Reading Screener (URS) Matrix outlines the appropriate grade-level assessments required to be administered during the tri-annual URS window (grades 4-6) and minimally one time per year with a fall administration for grades 7-8. While universal screening in reading for grades 4-8 is not required by the Tennessee Literacy Success Act, LEAs must conduct universal reading screeners to identify students who are at risk for academic struggle and to identify students in need of instructional and intervention supports.

LEAs are not required to utilize the screeners listed on this matrix in grades 4 – 8. Universal screeners must be a skills-based tool that produces a normed percentile composite score. Refer to the [RTI² Manual](#) for more information on universal screening in grades 4 – 8.
