We have outstanding opportunities to work in a beautiful work environment. This position is located at Chickasaw State Park in Henderson, TN. The Park has 13 cabins, three campgrounds, a group lodge and group camp, bathhouses, a visitor's center, and picnic shelters.

This position is responsible for leading the housekeeping team and ensuring quality standards are met in the housekeeping operations at the park. The position also has custodial responsibilities for the park's bathhouses, restrooms, and assembly hall. The preferred candidate will have experience equivalent to two years of full-time custodial work, including at least one year in a lead capacity. Applicants must possess a valid driver's license. The position requires the ability to work on some weekends and holidays. High School Diploma or GED is preferred.

Highlighted Responsibilities:

- Motivate and guide team by providing clear direction.
- Maintain accurate records and generate various reports.
- Generate requisitions for supplies as needed.
- Ensure work requests are completed on a timely basis.
- Complete all janitorial duties, such as, sweeping, mopping, sanitizing toilets, sinks, and showers.
- Perform and lead others in performing duties, such as, dusting, vacuuming, making beds, and cleaning kitchens.
- Share technical knowledge and skills to facilitate accomplishing projects as a team.
- Use human resource and facilities management software.
