General Responsibilities:

- Develop, maintain, update, and utilize customer database
- Lead and inspire employees to focus on the customer experience as a key priority
- Adhere to and enforce required fiscal and accounting policies related to accurate recordkeeping, payment of invoices, payment card processing, inventories, daily deposits, monthly reporting, etc.
- Ensure systems controls are in place to safeguard assets, revenues, resources
- Maintain safety standards and safety equipment within OSHA requirements
- Maintain course conditions in a safe and cost-effective manner for the enjoyment of generations to come
