NRS21.161	Applicant: CSX Transportation, Inc Activity: CSX Transportation proposed unavoidable impacts through fill of 3.58 acres of wetland, temporary impacts to 1.25 acres of wetland, and temporary impacts to 120 feet of an unnamed tributary to Big Muddy Creek associated with replacement of three failing rail line bridges and construction of an access road in Stanton (Haywood County). To offset the proposed impacts to wetlands, the applicant will purchase at least 7.16 wetland mitigation credits from the Hatchie Mitigation Bank.

Compensatory mitigation will be provided through purchase of wetland mitigation credits from the Swamp Road II Mitigation Bank and the Tennessee Mitigation Fund in-lieu fee program.
