

Keep smiling.

Ask your dentist for a cost estimate for dental lab work like crowns and bridges.



To help keep your smile healthy, your dental plan covers the cost of most preventive care. That includes cleanings and regular exams.

If you need more advanced care, you will be responsible for your copay and any related dental lab charges. Many dentists use dental labs to fabricate crowns, bridges and dentures. Dentists and labs set their own prices for lab work, so to avoid surprises, ask for an estimate before scheduling any major restorative work.

Copay + Dental Lab Charges = Out-of-Pocket Costs

Here are a few examples of your share of costs for restorative work, including lab charges.

Procedure	General dentist patient charge	Additional lab charge	Your total responsibility
Porcelain crown	\$265	\$360	\$625
Resin upper partial denture	\$310	\$500	\$810
Immediate full upper denture	\$365	\$500	\$865
