REQUEST FOR INFORMATION CONCERNING COMPETITION IN THE MARKET FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN THE STATE OF TENNESSEE

The Tennessee Public Utility Commission requests information from all telecommunications service providers to be used in the preparation of a mandatory report to the Tennessee General Assembly concerning competition in the communications market in Tennessee pursuant to T.C.A. 65-5-109(q). The Commission invites all telecommunications providers to provide the following information:

1. The counties where the provider serves residential customers;
2. The counties where the provider serves business customers;
3. The number of residential customers served by the provider, statewide; and
4. The number of business customers served by the provider, statewide.

In addition, the Commission requests information on the transport and switching technology used to provide telecommunications services, services and products offered in this state, and any other information the provider volunteers concerning future plans for deployment, new services, new technology or the scope of competition.

By statute, submission of the information in this Request is voluntary.
