

## RENEWAL PROCESS SUMMARY

During the federal public health emergency (PHE), the federal government temporarily paused required annual renewals for Medicaid coverage resulting in TennCare membership increasing by more than 25%. With the ending of the PHE, previous Medicaid eligibility laws and rules are now in effect and required TennCare renewals have resumed. For the month of April, slightly more than 80,000 TennCare members were due for renewal. The numbers below reflect the outcomes for those renewals started in April and the first month of the unwinding process.
