<b>2. Adherence to Antipsychotic Medications for Individuals With Schizophrenia (SAA)</b>	Percentage of members 19–64 years of age during the measurement year with schizophrenia or schizoaffective disorder who were dispensed and remained on an antipsychotic medication for at least 80% of their treatment period	≥65.00%
<b>3. Antidepressant Medication Management (adults only)- Effective Continuation Phase (AMM)</b>	Percentage of members 18 and older who were treated with antidepressant medication, had a diagnosis of major depression, and who remained on an antidepressant medication for at least 180 days (6 months)	≥40.00%
<b>4. Child &amp; Adolescent Well-Care Visits (WCV)</b>	Percentage of enrolled members 7-21 years of age who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a PCP or OB/GYN during the measurement year	≥65.00% ≥57.00% ≥39.00%
<b>5. Controlling High Blood Pressure (CBP)</b>	Percentage of members 18-85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension (HTN) and whose BP was adequately controlled (<140/90 mm Hg) during the measurement year	≥52.00%
<b>6. Diabetes Screening for People With Schizophrenia or Bipolar Disorder (SSD)</b>	The percentage of members 18–64 years of age with schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder or bipolar disorder, who were dispensed an antipsychotic medication and had a diabetes screening test during the measurement year	≥82.00%
<b>7. Eye Exam for Patients With Diabetes (EED)</b>	Percentage of members 18-75 years of age with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) who had an eye exam (retinal) performed	≥51.00%
<b>8. Follow-Up After Hospitalization for Mental Illness (FUH)</b>	Percentage of discharges for mental health illness which the member received follow-up to within 7 days of discharge	≥38.00%
<b>9. Metabolic Monitoring for Children and Adolescents on Antipsychotics (APM)</b>	The percentage of children and adolescents 1–17 years of age who had two or more antipsychotic prescriptions and had metabolic testing	≥38.00%
