State SIM Population Health Improvement Update

- Next steps:
 - Identify “driver” metrics for each of those key themes.
 - For example:
 - Key Theme : Social Determinants of Health
 - Drivers:
 - » Socioeconomic status
 - » Graduation rates
 - » 3rd graders reading on level
 - » Households in poverty
 - » Recidivism / incarceration rates
 - » Measures of discrimination
 - » Pre-School/Pre-K availability
 - » Food deserts
 - Identify available data to support each key theme and driver metric.
 - Develop set of currently available metrics, and aspirational metrics.
 - Evaluate current data surveillance systems for future expansion.
 - Develop interactive dashboard framework for reporting and online data visualization.
 - Publish final metrics and related guidelines as 2017 Update to the State Health Plan.
