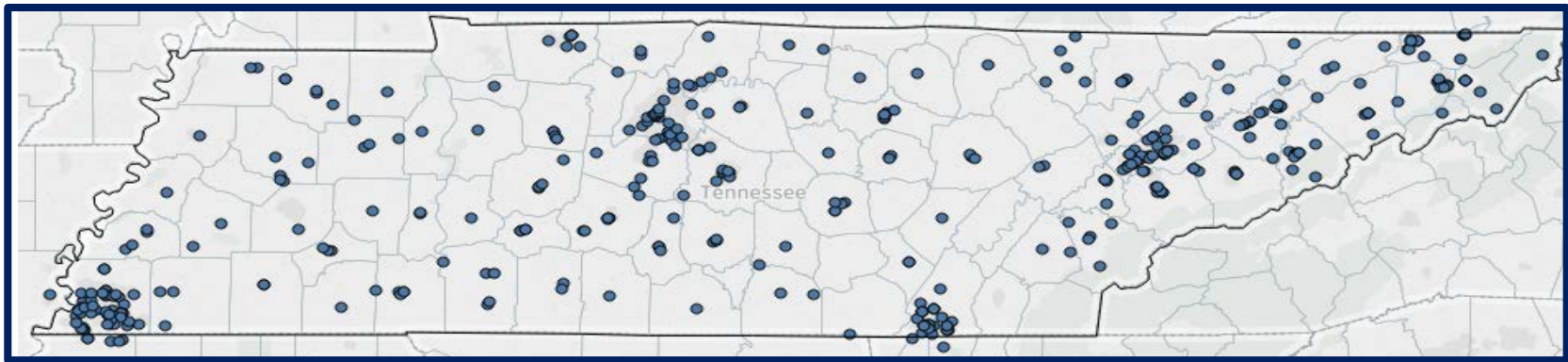

The table below shows current stats for PCMH wave 1, 2 & 3 organizations

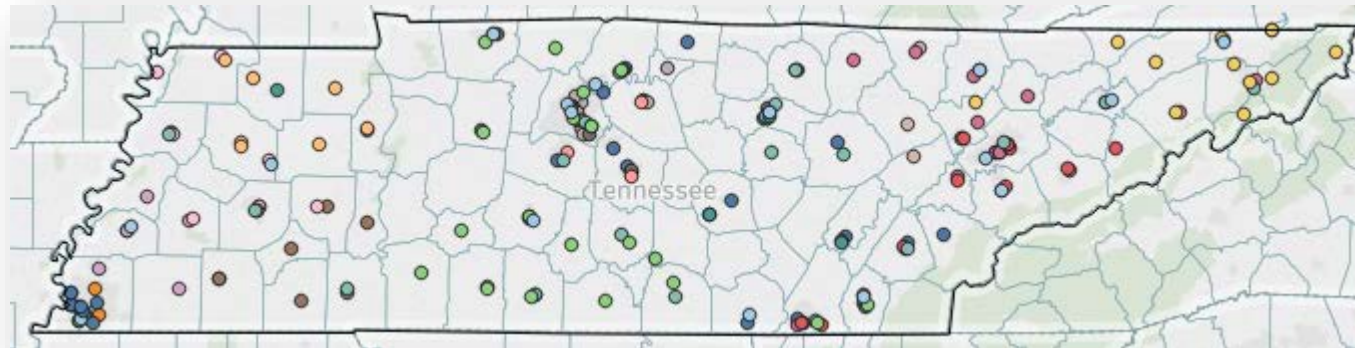

# Care Coordination Tool: Admission, Discharge, and Transfer (ADT) Data Update

- Admission, Discharge, and Transfer (ADT) feeds continue to be a significant data source for the PCMH and THL programs
- To date, with the exception of mental health institutes, **100%** of hospitals and licensed hospital beds statewide are submitting ADT data
- The most recent ADT feeds that have gone live in the CCT include:
  - **September 2018:** All 9 Covenant facilities from East Tennessee Health Information Network (etHIN)
  - **December 2018:** 11 Community Health Systems (CHS) facilities, including 10 Tennova facilities
  - **February 2019:** 2 remaining Tennova facilities
