Are there any corrections or</p> <p>6 additions to the agenda?</p> <p>7 (No verbal response.)</p> <p>8 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Okay. I'm not</p> <p>9 hearing any. Just as a point of order, so you</p> <p>10 know, our voting today will be roll call vote, and</p> <p>11 so I will call on the board members for them to</p> <p>12 vote on this item.</p> <p>13 So with that said, do I have a motion</p> <p>14 for adoption of the agenda?</p> <p>15 MR. BAUGHMAN: Dave Baughman, board</p> <p>7 member.</p> <p>8 Second.</p> <p>9 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you. I</p> <p>10 have a second. Any more discussion of the agenda?</p> <p>11 (No verbal response.)</p> <p>12 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: All right. I'm</p> <p>13 going to call the question.</p> <p>14 Mr. Baughman?</p> <p>15 MR. BAUGHMAN: Aye.</p> <p>16 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Mr. Bowers?</p> <p>17 MR. BOWERS: Aye.</p> <p>18 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: And I vote aye</p> <p>19 as well. So we do have an approved, adopted</p> <p>20 agenda.</p> <p>21 So moving on to Item 4, which is old</p> <p>22 business, we are going to discuss Item 20-17,</p> <p>23 LG Electronics. And they are requesting that</p> <p>24 vessels be classified as Tennessee Specials.</p> <p>25 So, Mr. Butler, I will turn that over</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">Page 13</p> <p>1 to you.</p> <p>2 MR. BUTLER: Yes, sir. I</p> <p>3 appreciate this opportunity. I know the last</p> <p>4 meeting, we were asked to look at the volume</p> <p>5 calculations on the vessels to eliminate those</p> <p>6 that were below the required cubic footage to be</p> <p>7 registered with the state, and, also, to have</p> <p>8 national board numbers.</p> <p>9 I've gone through and I've provided</p> <p>10 you-all with a list. It's the same list that I</p> <p>11 gave you the last meeting. I'm showing certain</p> <p>12 vessels in red. Those have been eliminated from</p> <p>13 consideration.</p> <p>14 There's also a sheet there where the</p> <p>15 vessels are listed showing the complete</p> <p>16 calculations for each vessel that is there. I</p> <p>17 made another trip and actually got on top of each</p> <p>18 press with a manlift to look at these vessels,</p> <p>19 look at the nameplate stampings. I know there was</p> <p>20 an issue brought up about some of the information</p> <p>21 nameplates on there being in hydrotest pressure,</p> <p>22 as opposed to pneumatic, which is what's listed on</p> <p>23 the data reports. Those nameplates have been</p> <p>24 replaced, as far as -- the informational nameplate</p> <p>25 was replaced so that now that information matches</p>

<p style="text-align: right;">Page 14</p> <p>1 what is on the data reports.</p> <p>2 I did check the relief valves on the</p> <p>3 vessels. They are in psi, as opposed to MPa.</p> <p>4 I've sent a conversion. I also had the plant put</p> <p>5 a label on each of those vessels near the</p> <p>6 nameplates showing what the psi rating is to make</p> <p>7 it easier for the inspectors to say, okay, here is</p> <p>8 the psi design pressure. That way they can</p> <p>9 reference the relief valve that's there.</p> <p>10 I think that's the only real issues</p> <p>11 that we were asked to address. I realize that</p> <p>12 we're asking a lot, asking for 23 vessels to have</p> <p>13 a Tennessee Special, but these vessels are -- were</p> <p>14 fabricated in accordance with ASME in Section 8,</p> <p>15 Division 1, and did receive all of the stamping</p> <p>16 that they should have as far as the safety</p> <p>17 calculations and the design conditions.</p> <p>18 The only issue was being in violation</p> <p>19 of state rules for having a national board in this</p> <p>20 state. But we do ask that you do issue a state</p> <p>21 special certification for these vessels so that</p> <p>22 the plant can continue to use them and operate.</p> <p>23 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you,</p> <p>24 Mr. Butler.</p> <p>25 Are there any conflicts of interest</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">Page 15</p> <p>1 from any of the board members?</p> <p>2 (No verbal response.)</p> <p>3 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Okay. I'm not</p> <p>4 hearing any conflict of interest. Do I have a</p> <p>5 motion to discuss?</p> <p>6 MR. BAUGHMAN: Dave Baughman, board</p> <p>7 member.</p> <p>8 I move a motion to discuss.</p> <p>9 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Okay. Do I</p> <p>10 have a second?</p> <p>11 MR. BOWERS: I second.</p> <p>12 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you</p> <p>13 Mr. Bowers and Mr. Baughman. What questions or</p> <p>14 comments do you have concerning this item?</p> <p>15 I will say, while people are</p> <p>16 thinking, Mr. Butler, thank you for the work to</p> <p>17 clarify the list of these 50 vessels. And I think</p> <p>18 it's -- you have addressed all the Board comments</p> <p>19 that I can think of right at the moment. I'll let</p> <p>20 the other board members speak to that. But you</p> <p>21 are correct. The state law requires a pressure</p> <p>22 vessel to be registered with the National Board.</p> <p>23 And that was not completed within the time limit</p> <p>24 provided by the National Board, so that's why we</p> <p>25 are considering making 23 of these vessels</p>
<p style="text-align: right;">Page 16</p> <p>1 Tennessee Special.</p> <p>2 And so from my review, I don't see</p> <p>3 any concerns. All of them have been addressed. I</p> <p>4 do want to reiterate to you-all that approval by</p> <p>5 the Board for each of these Tennessee Specials,</p> <p>6 they'll be stamped as Tennessee Specials, the 23</p> <p>7 vessels will be.</p> <p>8 And what that means to you as an</p> <p>9 owner or a user of these vessels, as these vessels</p> <p>10 require repair over their life, any repair to</p> <p>11 these Tennessee Special vessels will be required</p> <p>12 to have approval from the State of Tennessee from</p> <p>13 the Boiler Unit. And any alterations to these 23</p> <p>14 Tennessee Special vessels will require an item to</p> <p>15 be brought to the Tennessee Board of Boiler Rules</p> <p>16 for approval of that alteration prior to messing</p> <p>17 with that alteration.</p> <p>18 And that's the only comments I have.</p> <p>19 MR. BOWERS: This is Harold Bowers,</p> <p>20 board member.</p> <p>21 So from what I gathered, altogether,</p> <p>22 is now we're down to 23 vessels, and each of those</p> <p>23 vessels will have a nameplate or a sticker on the</p> <p>24 outside of those vessels with the MAWP, maximum</p> <p>25 allowed working pressure, converted to psi on the</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">Page 17</p> <p>1 outside of that vessel since the safety valves are</p> <p>2 actually in psi. Am I assuming that's all</p> <p>3 correct?</p> <p>4 MR. BUTLER: That is correct.</p> <p>5 MR. BOWERS: So once the Board</p> <p>6 approves it, and the boiler division will, I</p> <p>7 guess, identify each of those with a Tennessee</p> <p>8 Special number. Is that Tennessee special -- I</p> <p>9 guess there's a nameplate that is on each of these</p> <p>10 vessels. The Tennessee Special number will be,</p> <p>11 actually, stamped on that plate or will there be</p> <p>12 another plate that's actually attached to the</p> <p>13 vessel?</p> <p>14 MR. BUTLER: We can do either one.</p> <p>15 That's kind of up to Sam as how they put those on</p> <p>16 there or want those put on there.</p> <p>17 MR. BOWERS: This is Harold Bowers</p> <p>18 again.</p> <p>19 Sam, how are they usually identified</p> <p>20 with a Tennessee Special? Is the number stamped</p> <p>21 on that existing plate, or is another plate</p> <p>22 attached to the vessel with that Tennessee Special</p> <p>23 number on there?</p> <p>24 MR. CHAPMAN: Another plate would</p> <p>25 be stamped on it, and we'll get with Mr. Butler to</p>

He will give them the numbers 3 and they will stamp it on there as a Tennessee 4 Special.</p> <p>5 MR. BOWERS: Thank you, Sam. 6 MR. CHAPMAN: Uh-huh. 7 MR. BOWERS: No further questions 8 from me. 9 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you, 10 Mr. Bowers. 11 Anyone else have any questions or 12 comments about this item? 13 MR. BAUGHMAN: This is Dave 14 Baughman, board member. 15 I would like to say (speaking foreign 16 language) to Insik and Frank. Thank you both for 17 being here. 18 On the data -- (technology freezes). 19 That's me. Sorry. That's my pickle fingers. 20 On the data reports, it just shows 21 installation location unknown. I just wanted to 22 make sure that these units went directly to the 23 installation location and none have been 24 previously installed at any other location. 25 MR. BUTLER: No, sir. These</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">Page 19</p> <p>1 vessels were actually mounted on the presses when 2 they shipped from Korea. So they were on 3 brand-new vessels and put in as new equipment at 4 this plant. 5 MR. BAUGHMAN: Very good. Keith, 6 thank you. And I don't have any other questions. 7 I would say (foreign language). 8 MR. LEE: Thank you so much. 9 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you, 10 Mr. Baughman. 11 Does anyone else have any questions 12 before we vote this item? 13 (No verbal response.) 14 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: All right. 15 Hearing none, do I have a motion to approve 16 Item 20-17 for LG Electronics to have these 17 designated 23 vessels to be approved as Tennessee 18 Specials? 19 MR. BOWERS: This is Harold Bowers, 20 boiler inspector. 21 I make that motion to approve the 22 23 vessels to be approved as Tennessee Specials. 23 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you, 24 Mr. Bowers. 25 Do I have a second?</p>

BAUGHMAN: Dave Baughman, board 2 member. 3 Second. 4 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Thank you, 5 Mr. Baughman. 6 Any other questions or comments? 7 (No verbal response.) 8 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: All right. 9 Hearing none, I'll call the question. 10 Mr. Baughman? 11 MR. BAUGHMAN: Aye. 12 CHAIRMAN MORELOCK: Mr. Bowers? 13 MR. 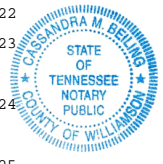
