Durham School Services, L.P. has filed an official WARN Notice with the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, notifying the agency of a permanent closure which is effective June 30, 2019. The total number of affected workers is 314. This company has locations at 2501 Dodds Avenue, Chattanooga, TN 37407, 3074 Hickory Valley Road, Chattanooga, TN 37421, and 5705 Middle Valley Road, Hixson, TN 37343. The company notified the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development's Dislocated Worker Unit on April 5, 2019.

The employees at the facility are represented by a collective bargaining agreement. The Southeast Local Workforce Development Area rapid response team, employed by the Southeast TN Development District, has been notified to coordinate services with the employer and affected employees. The Southeast Local Workforce Development Board will be responsible for the oversight of the continued follow up of Rapid Response and Dislocated Worker services associated with this event.
